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#### MGNREGA : EFFECTIVENESS OF MGNREGA IN HARYANA "A CASE STUDY OF VILLAGE- RANSIKA"

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#### **INTRODUCTION**

Ransika is a small village located in Pataudi Tehsil of Grugaon District Haryana. In the Ransika village total 169 families lived. Total population of Ransika village has 973 people 497 are males while 476 female per population census 2011. In Ransika village population of children with age (0-6) is 148. In Ransika village out of total population (973), 54 household has applied for registration under MGNREGA and Gram Panchayat issued the job card to the household. But women participation is very low in MGNREGA activity in Ransika village.

**Bigi Thomes and Ruby Bhatiya (2012)** conducted his study on evaluation of the MGNREGA scheme is intended to access the impact of this scheme on the overall quality of life of people by giving different parameters associated with the important of overall quality of life of people such as impact on income–earning levels of each household, expenditure on food and non-food items. Expenditure on education, household and cultivable assets certain by the beneficiaries. The study based on primary data .

**Vijay Kumar** reported that the social audit is an important weapon to attract the corruption that plagues rural development programmes .Social audit is an innovative mechanism that can create the enabling conditions for public accountability. The study is based on secondary data. It is the case study of three districts Sirsa, Ambala and Hisar in Haryana. In 2011-12 in the Gram Panchayat Tandwal no social audit was conducted because the MGNERGA was not came into force during this period in this Gram Panchayat. In the year 2011-12 (66.67%) of the total Gram Panchayats conducted 2 social audits. In the year 2012-13 all the selected Gram Panchayats performed excellence. All Gram Panchayat conducted 100% social audits. In the year 2012-13, in only two gram panchayat issues were raised. In the year 2013-14 also in only two gram panchayats issues were raised. All these show that the performance of MGNREGA and social audit is good.

**Keshlata and Dr. Syed Nadeem Fatmi (2015),** reported that the contribution of MGNREGA in the empowerment of the Scheduled Tribes through poverty alleviation and rural development in the Sheopur district of Madhya Pradesh . In this study highlight the role of MGNREGA to alleviate the poverty of India. Majority of ST is in Madhya Pradesh 14.7 crore. Through this study writer try to focus the impact of MGNREGA on poverty alleviation and rural development in the study area in Sheopur District MP








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


Table 1.6 Show the agency of Ransika village where the people got the Job card.100% people in Ransika village give the response that they got the job card in Panchayat.



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




Table 1.9 Show the mode of payment in Ransika village. Out of 54 people, 100% People says that wages is given through bank account.

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


Table 1.10 Show the demand of work and provided of the work to the job card holders in Ransika village. In the response 100% job card holders says that when they demand the work, work provided



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
